TEAM NOMINATION

- \$ 1600 Per Team due round 5
- \$200 rebate if paid by round 3
- If teams pull out after round 1 full fees still need to be paid
- Delegates meeting - if you attend your team gets 3 bonus points

INDIVIDUALS

- To take the field you have to be registered

GAME TIMES & DETAILS

- Seniors 2 x 20min halves 3 min half time
- Timeslots 6pm, 6.50pm, 7,40pm, 8.30PM (If needed)

WASH OUT CONTINGENCY

- Rounds washed out between 1-4 will be played on the Saturday Washout weekend.
- Should the washout weekend be Washed out it will be moved back by 1 week
- Rounds washed out between 5-6 in Term 1 will be played as a double header the week after.

\$60 PER YEAR - NATIONAL & STATE REGISTRATION

- Charged on first registration of financial year (1st July to 30th June)
- This is NOT a Dodgers Touch Fee
- \$30 is nationally recognised and covers you in every TFA affiliate
- \$30 is State recognised and covers you in every QTF affiliate

MINIMUM AGE

- **Seniors** - For the **safety** of participants we recommend the minimum age is turning 13 by 31st December the year of the season played.
- **Juniors** - At request of the Competition Coordinator, parents must be able to provide birth certificate if needed
- **Juniors** - All players must not be over the age of the division nominated as of 31st December. E.g. If you are born in 2013 in the year 2026 you are turning 13, you must play U14 not U12.

DIVISIONS

- **Mixed** Maximum male players on the field at any one time is 3
- **Mixed** Minimum number of male players on the field at any one time is 1.
- Any changes to split of players on the field will be advised by competition manager, this may also change finals of competition.
- **Divisions** - Players are only allowed to play in 1 division of the registered competition. You are allowed to play in multiple competitions (Mens, Juniors, Mixed competitions)
- **Juniors** - No Junior Team may consist of more than 5 representative players.
*Conditions will apply NOTE - A representative player has participated in an SQBD representative fixture during the previous 12 months.

FORFEITS & LATE STARTS

- It is the responsibility of **each captain** to report to the referees two minutes before the start of the game so the coin toss can be affected without loss of time.
- If a team is not at the field at the advertised starting time of the game, the attending team is awarded winning the toss.
- The offending team will receive a maximum of five (5) minutes from the commencement of the game (siren/whistle) to position the team on the field and be ready to commence play.
- If the offending team is not in attendance after the five (5) minutes has expired, the game will be deemed a forfeit win to the non offending team.
- If a team is late, one point may be awarded to the opposition team for every minute up to and including 5 points. Referee will determine allocated time.
- Any team that forfeits without notice more than once during the course of competition rounds WILL NOT be eligible for FINALS.

COMPETITION POINTS

WIN = 3 DRAW = 2 LOSS = 1 BYE = 0
FORFEIT LOSS = 0 FOREIT WIN = 3

WET WEATHER

- We always have every intention to play. Always assume the games are on. Unless you see a social media post & receive a database notification email asap its off.
- If fields are open, and severe weather hits before or during, we will communicate, venue 1st, social media 2nd, email 3rd.

FORCED MAJEURE

If LABRADOR DODGERS Touch are unable to perform, in whole or part in any obligation under these regulations of a Force Majeure Event, Labrador Dodgers Touch is relieved of that obligation under these regulations to the extent, and the period it is unable to perform.

In addition to this, Labrador Dodgers Touch has no obligation to refund to any individual or team any fees paid if it is unable to perform by reason of a Force Majeure Event.

FORCE MAJEURE EVENT: for the purposes of these regulations a force majeure event includes but is not limited to any or all of the following:

- Acts of God including flood, drought, earthquake, storm, cyclone, fire, explosion, epidemic; or
- War or Act of Terrorism; or Riot or civil disturbances; or
- Permanent injunction of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction; or
- Any fact, circumstance, matter or thing beyond the reasonable control of LD/TA/ TFA.

BLOOD BIN

- Any player with a bleeding cut or abrasion is to leave the field immediately and have the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered. At this time, any blood stained clothing must also be either cleaned or replaced.
- If the player does not leave the field immediately, the Referee will stop the game and ask the player to leave the field (normal substitution rules apply).
- Once the flow of blood has been stemmed, the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered and any blood stained clothing and equipment cleaned or replaced, the player may return to the field and continue play. If bleeding cannot be controlled and the wound securely covered, the player must not continue in the game

MUTAL RESPECT POLICY

- Referees will be instructed to enforce zero tolerance rules regarding referee abuse from players, coaching staff and spectators.
- Teams/Players/Coaches and spectators are bound by the Disciplinary Regulations Manual and 8th edition rules.
- Teams/players/spectators that consume or introduce alcohol at the venue outside the laws associated with liquor license requirements will be asked to leave.

PROTEST

- Protests will be heard and determined by the Judiciary and or designated Protest Committee.
- The Competition Committee will form the Protest Committee. It will include at least three committee members or persons designated by the committee.
- The Competition Committee will collect relevant information, requests, score cards, score sheets & referee reports.
- Protests must be lodged in writing by Team Delegate within twenty (20) minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, to the Competition Coordinator or to an official designated by Labrador Dodgers Executive Committee Member .
- The protest will then be investigated and the Team Manager or their nominated representative will be notified of the decision
- Any notice to be served on any person to attend a hearing, will be served on the Team Manager or nominated representative of the team involved, and any such service is deemed to be served on all parties or persons under the control of that Team Manager or their nominated representative

LOST AND FOUND

- All items found at the fields are subject to the following Lost & Found Policy
- Water Bottles - Are available for collection for 7 days before thrown out
- Articles of Clothing - Are available to the end of the season before donated to Salvation Army School
- Clothing donated to school at end of term
- Valuables such as but not limited to wallet, phone, watch, ipad, sunglasses will be handed in to Runaway Bay Police station for collection no later than 48hrs after found.

INSURANCE

TEAM DELIGATE RESPONSIBILITIES



TEAM DELEGATE - \$0 PER TEAM

- Nominate a team at www.labradortouch.com/play
- Send Link to players and have them register in accordance with the terms and conditions with their correct information
- Attend delegates meeting



ONLY ALLOW REGISTERED PLAYERS TO PLAY

- Ensure no team members take the field that are not on the team sheet
- Teams that play unregistered players may forfeit competition points (1 point per unregistered player)



MINIMUM PLAYERS PER TEAM

- All teams must have a minimum of 9 players per team For U12 &14 and 6 per team for U10
- Teams below this number will be removed from the draw



BE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR TEAM

Ensure all players;

- are familiar with the conditions of entry and 8th edition rules.
- in the team behave in an appropriate manner on and off the field before, during and after the game.



HAVE ALL PLAYERS IN UNIFORM

- All players must be in team uniform by Round 3 (singlet/shirt)
- Shirts must be numbered on the back with a 16cm number.
- Shorts must not have external pockets
- Light leather or synthetic boots with moulded soles are permitted.
- A loss of 1 try per player for incorrect uniform



ASSIST THE CLUB

- Report any facility concerns to the Competition Manager
- Encourage Players to become referees



GAME NIGHT

- Keep in contact with your team (Competition times, updates ect)
- Bring a ball to the field

RESPONSIBILITIES

JUNIOR PLAYERS

- Parent/Guardian Nominates Child online and agrees to TFA, QTF & PBT Declarations
- Parent/Guardian of participants must be present at the venue
- Parent/Guardian must abide by all club & sport policies

INDIVIDUALS

- All players to be registered to team before taking the field

COACHES

Must register online as a coach;

- If any players in your team are under the age of 18, or if a Teacher must have an 'exemption' card.
- You do not need to register for a blue card if you are a parent or guardian to a child in the team you are coaching.

REFEREES

- Must be registered with the Referee Director Referee in accordance with the 8th edition rules
- Be at the field 5 minutes before their game
- Mark the scorecard or game sheet correctly
- Seniors: Ensure Captains or coaches sign off on scorecard
- Juniors: Ensure Coach or Team Delegate sign off on scorecard

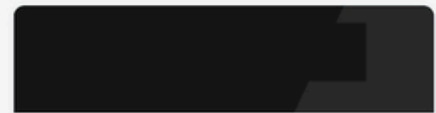
